Topics include (but are not limited to) metaphor processing, processing other types of non-literal meaning, assessing pragmatic skills in typical and atypical conditions, developmental pragmatics.
Research Group	The research group is composed by the newly established team of the Laboratory of Neurolinguistics and Experimental Pragmatics, which includes the PI Valentina Bambini, one lab manager with experience in EEG, two postdoctoral fellows with experience in neuropragmatics and computational models of language, and 4 PhD students with different projects related to pragmatics and metaphor. The Lab is fully equipped for behavioral and EEG experiments. Furthermore, the MSCA fellow will have the opportunity to work in connection with other ongoing projects including the ERC consolidator Grant PROMENADE focusing on metaphor processing (https://cordis.europa.eu/project/id/101045733). The Lab provides a lively community of collaborators at national and international level and organizes on a regular basis seminars and workshops, also in connection with the XPRAG.it network, which would contribute to the training activities planned for the MSCA fellow.
